The Voice of Jesus

Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. [Jhn 5:25 KJV]

Notice what this text DOES NOT SAY

The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the preacher. No, it is the voice of The Son of God.

If it takes the words or voice of the preacher to get a person born again then that creates a gigantic problem.

Notice this.

Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. [Jhn 5:28-29 KJV]

I believe the voice in verse 25 is the same one in verse 28.

So if you believe those who are dead (in trespasses and sins) are made alive by the voice or words of the preacher, then by course you will need to voice of the preacher to raise you from the grave at the last day.

See the problem?
